

## China Course in China, the academic year 2019 – 2020

This course gives you an opportunity to learn, live in and work with a completely new and different culture. You will gain these experiences as part of a group of Scandinavians, in a setting where there are many opportunities to get to know different aspects of China, for example people, society, traditions, cultures, ethnic groups, and so on.

The course is built upon the student's interest in China and Asia, the desire to get to know some Chinese language, her history, religion and culture. There is also an opportunity to choose different tracks, such as *Culture, Language or Diaconia (Social work)*. There are possibilities to test some creative work such as painting, calligraphy, music, dance, kungfu, different creative workshops at NORDICA ARTS CENTER (NAC), in Kunming, China with Chinese, Swedish, or international teachers teach the subjects.

You will study approximately 20 hours/week. There will be practical work along the study, around the same amount of the time. The practical work will be at Nordica and outside, where you will be responsible for some tasks in the culture exchange between East and West. There is always an opportunity with voluntary work and the workload varies throughout the year.

### About Nordica Arts Center

*Nordica Arts Center is located in the south of Kunming from April 2019*

The course is housed at Nordica Arts Center, a Chinese-Scandinavian culture center in Kunming, China. This is a meeting place for people from East and West, for artists, children, families, musicians, students, volunteers, etc. They will focus a lot of art education but also have culture, such as exhibitions, concerts, performances, workshops, and of course, making new friends! You can find it at "Lonely planet", the well-know tourist guidebook.

The vision of Nordica Arts Center is to ***"stimulate reflection on human worth as expressed in various art forms"***.

## About Kunming

Kunming is the capital city of Yunnan, which locates in southwest China, also is home to 26 ethnic groups. The weather is sub-tropical, and the landscape and culture are diverse and unique. It's a popular tourist attraction in China. Kunming is a rapid developing city, with tradition along the development. There are 7 million people living here. China is the same, a fascinating country, which now goes through a time of quick changes and developments, and in which, you will explore old and new, history and modernization, and other surprises.



## The purpose of the course is to ...

- Give an overview of contemporary China through study of current society, history, philosophy, religion, and culture.
- Provide an introduction to the Chinese language through active language studies

designed to cope with daily life communication.

- Nurture reflection on the outside world, the differences between countries and cultures in the East and the West.
- Provide the students with the opportunity to focus their studies on one of three tracks: Culture, Language, or Diaconia (Social work).
- Offer internship - and volunteer opportunities at Nordica AC and other organizations in Kunming.
- Provide an understanding of faith- and life issues from a Christian perspective based on TCG Nordica's vision.

## Schedule

Fall semester: August 19 –December 31, 2019.

Spring semester: January 8 – June 5, 2020.

(According to the Swedish system CSN).

The course starts and ends at Hyllie Park folk high school (HPF) in Malmö.

In Advent and Christmas time we have a lot of practical work and different activities where we show different Scandinavian traditions at Nordica AC.

The Chinese New Year 2020 is in the end of January and early February, and Nordica AC is closed during that time.

## Meeting days in Malmö, Sweden

To be able to join the course you will have a Skype interview and we are also happy to invite you to an info day in June 1<sup>st</sup> 2019 at HPF in Malmö, if it's possible for you to come. We start Saturday at 10:00 and will meet the students from recent year. They will have a lecture about their year in China and you will meet the leader of the course. We will give you a lot of information about Asia, China, Kunming and Nordica AC. After an interview that day or by Skype, you are accepted for the coming year course in China.

The course starts the 19<sup>th</sup> of August 2019 and will have a couple of days at HPF in Malmö. Then the group will travel together to Beijing for a Study trip for some days and then go to

Kunming in the south of China. HPF will help the whole group to book the roundtrip flight tickets from Copenhagen to Kunming (and the way back). Round trip flight ticket will cost approximately 10 -12.000 SEK.

## Introduction in China

The academic year in China will start with a short study trip to Beijing followed by two weeks of introduction to many practical things about living in China, as well as of the teachers and the schedule. These two weeks will also be used for preparing the first performance. TCG Nordica and the staff will also be presented to you.

## The Chinese language

The purpose of this subject is to learn the basics of the Chinese language and to be able to use it in simple ways in daily life. 4-6 h/w is teacher-led lessons by university teachers in Kunming City.

## Knowledge about China and Asia

In this subject the focus is on understanding today's China by looking from different angles: from her history, philosophy/religion and culture. The history of China is fascinating and her culture is rich and deep. China has the largest population in the world. As a country China develops very fast. The differences between countryside and the city are huge, but even within the city the contrasts are big. The subject gives space to discuss and explore both what is being experienced and studied in books.

## Creative work

In this subject we meet Chinese teachers who in different ways work with Arts, such as music, painting, calligraphy, dance, pottery, woodcarving. Students can choose to work in a field that interests him/her both individually and in group, both with a teacher and without.

## Team time

There will be time for the team to reflect upon faith and life, and also to meet Chinese and foreign people who will share their life stories.

## Time in class

Every week there is time to meet as a class for reflection. For this type of education it is important that the students can influence the content and the development of the course as a whole. There will also be time to follow up the practical work.

## Practical work

An important part of the course is the practical work. The students take part in some of the planning and implementation of different culture programs at Nordica AC. The tasks vary from performing at the evening program, giving Chinese people a chance to practice English, managing the sound and light system or work with the website. The work involves building relationships with Chinese people who want to get to know Scandinavian culture, practice English and make friends.

Your individual choice of track will also influence what practical work you will take part in.

### **Study trips**

In the autumn the group will make a study trip together. This will give a good opportunity to get to know each other better, but also to acquaint the group with the countryside and famous places in Yunnan, such as Dali and Lijiang, and meet some of the many minorities living in the province. There will be other study tours during the year as well. During the vacations (between fall and spring semester, and after Chinese New Year) there are many opportunities to go to nearby countries, for example Thailand, Laos, Vietnam and Burma.

### **Project work**

During the Spring semester each of the students work with a project, individually or in a group. The project work belongs to one of the subjects and track. It consists of some creative work, social or other work.

### **Good to know**

The life and work at Nordica Arts Center is a lot about building relationships. In and through them you will be able to give and receive. You will for sure work some evenings. You will be engaged in some of Nordica's programs and arrangements. There are Chinese volunteers who sometimes perform here, which is one of the groups of people you will meet.

### **Costs**

#### **- Term fee**

Term fee is 2500 CNY/term. This includes three study trips and teaching materials. The students pay themselves for study books, which are cheap in China. You pay when you have arrived to Kunming.

#### **- Flight ticket**

Round trip flight ticket from Copenhagen to Kunming (and the way back) will cost approximately 10 -12.000 SEK. Usually HPF

will help you to book the roundtrip ticket of Copenhagen and Beijing. Course leader in Kunming will help you to book the ticket from Beijing to Kunming. Therefore the payments are made separately.

#### **- Housing**

The students live in furnished flats, which they share with other students. The cost is 1500 CNY/month x 10 months. It includes water, gas, electricity, internet etc. It does not include drinking water.

The rent is to be paid in cash in CNY monthly or for the whole semester in advance, if it is possible. This amount will not be refunded in the case of leaving the course.

#### **- Food**

Eating in China is very cheap. According to estimation one person could eat for 1.500-2.000 CNY/month. At Nordica there is possibility to order coffee, tea, and small cakes.

#### **- Money**

The Chinese currency is RMB/CNY/Yuan. It is easy to get cash at ATMs using Visa or Master card. Cash is needed everywhere; it is seldom possible to pay with credit card. In February 2018 the currency rate is CNY100: SEK135.

#### **- Transportation**

It is easy to travel by bus and metro in Kunming and the cost is usually 2-6 CNY. The best way of transportation may be by bicycle. A new bike costs about 600 CNY.

### **Visa in Sweden and residence permit in China**

We will give more information at the information days.

For 2019-20, the first entry visa is 1300 SEK. You need to switch the entry visa to residence permit when you arrive in China, which will cost around 3000 CNY. It is paid to Yunnan University of Nationalities in Kunming, and it

includes residence permit, administration fee, insurance required by the university, etc.

### **Vaccination**

Contact a local vaccination healthcare center.

### **Insurance**

We will inform you about this on the interview and the cost is 28 SEK per day by Europeiska (ERV) during the whole year. It will be paid during the year in China.

You can also fix it by your family insurance, if it's possible.

### **Spare time**

It is easy to have a rich spare time in Kunming. Everything is available if you are willing to pay, but you can also enjoy the beautiful nature and take trips to different places in and around Kunming. During the year it might be possible to do shorter journeys in smaller groups and also to have visitors coming.

There will be two days per week with no lessons where you can choose to do your homework, be at Nordica or take time for yourself.

### **CSN (Swedish financial aid)**

Log in at CSN.se and make an application on their website. When you apply for this course you mark if you want to apply for CSN funds. When you apply you need to understand that this course is a Swedish course and the name is "Kinakurs". (Note! You do not apply for studies abroad 'utlandsstudier', because it is a Swedish course, located in another country.)
